




Y6 Homework

MATHS

1. Log on to Times Tables Rock Stars to access homework tasks

Children will be tested each week on their times tables and division facts - they will be told which ones to learn by their teacher. Certificates will be awarded in assembly to children who are successfully meeting the challenges set by the class teacher.

If your child is unable to access the internet, Rock Star Club will be available to children in school once a week on Thursday.

2. Look at the Maths Home Learning Activities to support your child in maths.

READING

Each day the children are expected to read at home and have their reading journal or record signed by an adult. A badge will be presented in celebration assembly for those who have read 6 chapter books. Children should be reading for at least 15 minutes every evening or morning. **Due Date: Every Thursday.**
